

## Overview of Projects Awarded During the Current Year (2025)

Figures 1&2 show that the number of projects awarded in January was the highest at 15 projects, while as for the financial value, April was the highest with more than 13 Billion SAR.

### Number of Projects for 2025




Figure 1: Number of projects awarded in the first 4 months of 2025.




Figure 2: The value of projects awarded in the first 4 months of 2025.

## Projects awarded to Contractors in April 2025 by Industry

According to SCAVO (construction projects tracking platform), a total of 13 projects were awarded in April 2025 with a combined value exceeding 13 billion SAR. The Building and Construction sector accounted for 39% of the total number of projects with 5 projects. And for the financial value, the Power & Water sector was the highest with more than 10 billion SAR representing 79% of the total projects values for April 2025.




Figure 3: Percentage of awarded projects distributed by sector.

## Regional Distribution of the Projects Awarded During April 2025

Riyadh Province accounted for the most awarded projects in April, with 6 projects Accounted for 85% of the total projects.




Figure 4: The Number of projects distributed by region.




Figure 5: The Values of projects distributed by region.

**Figure 5 shows the projects' values by region.** It indicates that Madina Province is the leading region in terms of the total value of projects, with value exceeding 6.8 billion SAR.

## The Expected Project Completion Year for the Projects Awarded During April 2025

It is expected that 7 of the projects awarded in April 2025 will be delivered within 2027 which accounted for 53% of the total projects, while 6 projects will deliver within 2026, 2028 and 2030.

## The Top Five Project Owners, Based on the Value of Their Awarded Projects in April 2025

Saudi Electricity Company (SEC) is the top project owner in April in terms of the Value of projects, with value exceeding 7 billion SAR. While as for the number of projects, Saudi Electricity Company, Lenovo and Alat had an equal number of projects, with 2 projects assigned to each company.




Figure 7: The top five project owners, based on the value of their awarded projects in April 2025.
