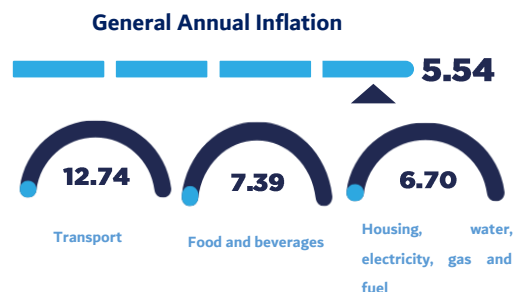


Digital Dubai:

5.54% increase in the Consumer Price Index in August 2026

According to the report issued by the Dubai Data and Statistics Establishment at the Dubai Digital Authority, the annual inflation recorded an increase of 5.54% in August 2026 compared to the same period in 2025, and in detail, the Transport division recorded the highest increase of 12.74%, as a result of the increase in Fuels and Lubricants for Personal Transport Equipment by 31.29% and Passenger transport by air by 23.16%. Food and beverages division increased by 7.39%. Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Fuel division recorded an increase of 6.70%, as a result of the growth of the average residential rental prices in most areas of the Emirate during August 2026 compared to the same period of the previous year.



The General Monthly Consumer Price Index recorded an increase of 0.31% in August 2026 compared to July 2026. Clothing and Shoes division recorded the highest increase of 2.85%.

At the annual level, the change in goods and services



The most prominent divisions in inflation were Fuels and Lubricants for Personal Transport Equipment by 31.29%, which falls under the Transport division, followed by Passenger transport by air by 23.16%, which falls under the Transport division, followed by Pulses and Vegetables by 22.13%, which falls under the Food and beverages division.



The most prominent divisions in the decrease were Equipment for the reception, recording and reproduction of sound and vision by 12.57%, which falls under the Information and Communications division, followed by other clothing and clothing accessories by 8.52%, which falls under the Clothing and Shoes division, followed by a decrease in Stationery and drawing materials by 3.85%, which falls under the Recreation, sport and culture division.

On the monthly level, the change in goods and services



The most prominent divisions in inflation were Shoes and other footwear by 11.14%, which falls under the Clothing and Shoes division, followed by the increase in Accommodation Services by 8.00%, which falls under the Restaurants and accommodation services division, followed by Fuels and Lubricants for Personal Transport Equipment by 5.39%, which falls under Transport division.



The most prominent divisions in the decrease were Passenger transport by air by 9.83%, which falls under the Transport division, followed by Stationery and drawing materials by 4.96%, which falls under the Recreation, sport and culture division, followed by Fish and seafood by 4.85%, which falls under the Food and beverages division.
