Al Hilal Club Company continued moving steadily toward a future in which sporting leadership integrates with institutional excellence. This institutional excellence is built on the club's iconic legacy, the unlimited support from the Saudi government, and a national vision that competes with the world across all fields.

The 2024/2025 season was a witness to a qualitative stage in the journey of the club and the Al Hilal Club Company.

It was a year in which Al Hilal's position as a global sporting power was solidified, as our champions delivered an exceptional performance during the 2025 FIFA Club World Cup in America. Al Hilal set a precedent within international football, eliminating the European champion, and then reaching the quarterfinals in one of the largest global football arenas among the world's elite clubs.

Al Hilal's glory was not confined to the pitch; it extended to more achievements in administration, commerce, organization, and digital transformation. The company continued progressing toward the board of directors' strategic objectives by achieving integration and sustainability across all sectors. Moreover, the company accelerated efforts to develop operational systems, elevate staff capabilities, and expand strategic partnerships through signing 10 new sponsorship agreements, including two with international sponsors.

Furthermore, efforts continued toward developing the sports and health facilities at the club's headquarters, alongside signing an agreement to establish an advanced sports training center in partnership with Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University with specifications that keep pace with the highest international standards. The impact of this new center is expected to manifest after preparing an ideal

performance environment. Additionally, the capacity of the Kingdom Arena stadium was increased by 41%, with the addition of 14 new VIP boxes.

The company also continued to achieve record results in governance and financial efficiency evaluations in addition to its effective presence in sports academies front and Al Hilal Charity Foundation's initiatives which are an essential pillar of Al Hilal's mission to the community.

On the media front, the new content strategy contributed to gaining approximately 4 million new followers across various social media platforms; 55% of whom are international followers. This is in addition to the launch of the new WhatsApp channel, which attracted more than 540,000 followers in its first year. Al Hilal now possesses 42.6 million followers across various social platforms, confirming its strength on the international stage on par with many major European clubs.

Today, we confidently move toward a more prosperous future as we believe that what has been achieved would not have seen the light were it not for the club's spirit, its passionate fans, dedicated technical and administrative staff, and unstoppable passionate workers. We promise you that leadership will remain our responsibility, ambition our approach, and glory our path.





Growth rate compared to the previous season








As part of the ongoing efforts to raise facility efficiency and its compliance with safety and maintenance standards,


